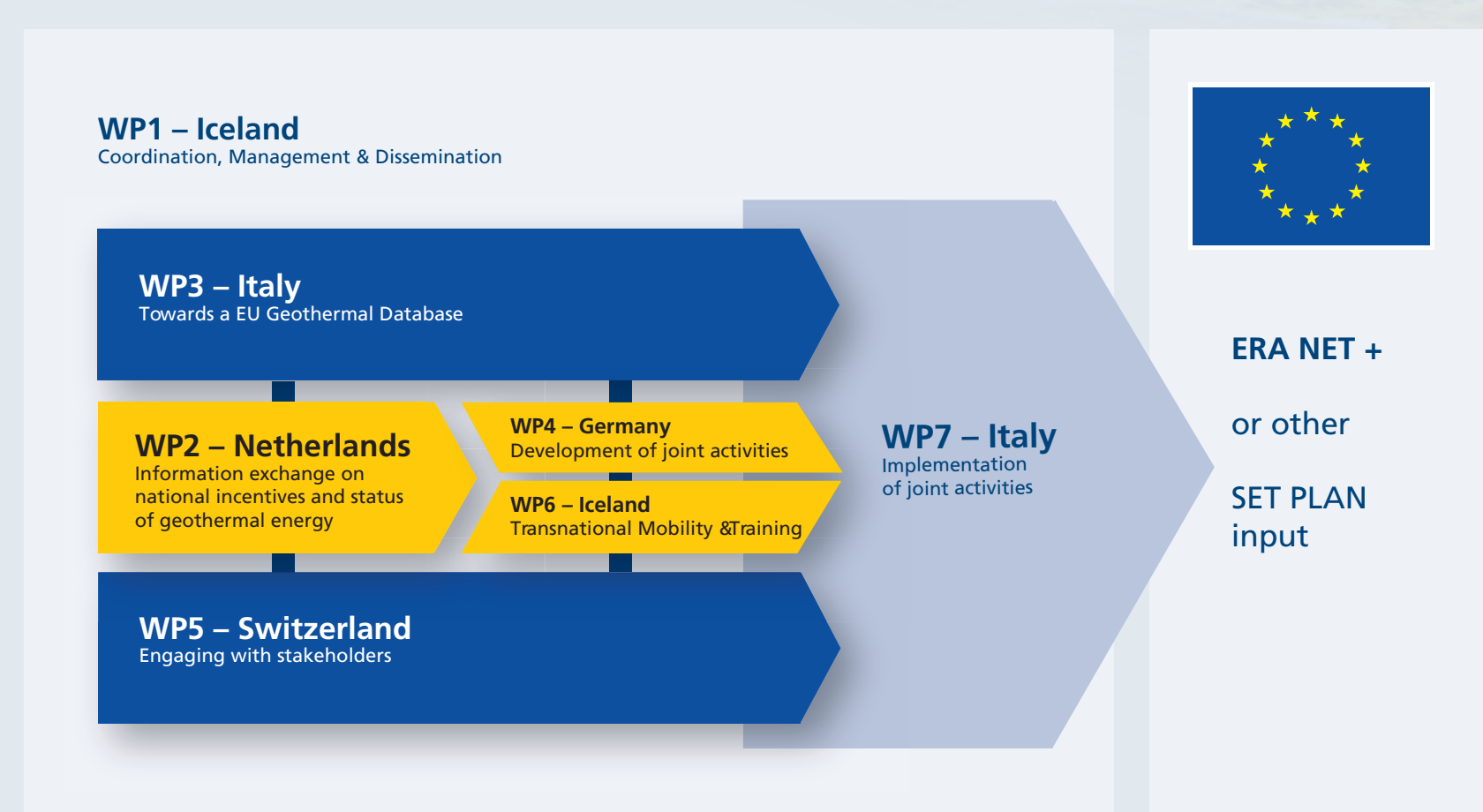


# Cooperation between European countries through the GEOTHERMAL ERA-NET
